Year 2 Curriculum

We have devised a knowledge rich curriculum, based on the National Curriculum programmes of study, which sequences knowledge, concepts and skills. We have a 'Big Question' which we aim to answer through our learning and the children generate their own questions that they want to answer

Reading

Your child will read regularly in school but we do expect every child to read for at least 20 minutes everyday at home and for their reading record to be signed by an adult stating how well your child has read. You could also include any words they found tricky and need more practise with.

We are continuing to follow the Read Write Inc programme for teaching phonics and reading. This means your child will read the same book for three days before it is changed. The first read is to become familiar with the text, the second read is to build fluency and the third read is to build comprehension skills and talk about the text.

Please ensure your child brings their book bag and reading log (Monkey Book) every day.

<u>Spellings</u>

Children that have finished the Read Write Inc spellings programme will be set spellings weekly. Please bring your spelling book in on a **Friday** when you will be tested.

## Maths Homework—CGP Mental Maths Workbooks



Each week you will need to complete **one** page of your Key Stage One Maths CGP Mental Workout Maths Booklet. Everyone needs to complete Section A (Start up) and B (Into Gear) of each page. If you want more of a challenge you can also complete Section C (Tough challenge). Please bring into school on **Friday** to have that week's exercise marked by your teacher.

## 99 Club

99 Club will take place on a **Thursday**. This is a weekly mental arithmetic check to practise addition, number bonds and times tables. Remember you need to get all the answers correct three weeks in a row to move up to the next level. Every little bit of practise helps!

## Times Tables

Please help your child to learn their times tables. All children by the end of Key Stage 1 should know their 2s, 5s and 10s and for an extra challenge their 3s.

## <u>Snacks</u>

Your child will be provided with a free fruit snack to eat during the morning break.

## Start of the school day

KS1 children should wait on the KS1 playground with their parent/carer ready for the start of the school day. Please arrive promptly, on time for **8.45 am**. Your child's class teacher will come to the KS1 playground to collect the children and take them into school.

## End of the school day

The school day ends at 3.05pm. Please wait on the KS1 playground for your child to be sent to you to go home. Let us know in advance, either by telling the class teacher or school office, if you have arranged for your child to be collected by somebody different.

## School Uniform

School uniform is a requirement and consists of the following:

Black sensible shoes (no heels or trainers please).

Trainers or plimsolls.

Tracksuits are suitable in winter.
